Itinerary

3 Sep 09 Fly Australia – Beijing

Board your international flight bound for Beijing; overnight on plane

4 Sep 09 Arrive Beijing

Welcome to Beijing, the capital city of China; rest of the day we visit the unique Temple of Heaven; enjoy the welcome Peking duck dinner; stay at 4 star hotel for 3 nights (D)

5 Sep 09 Beijing

Walk on Tiananmen Square, the largest public square in the world; explore the magnificent Forbidden City, used to the royal residence; marvel in the Summer Palace, the largest imperial garden in China (B/L/-)

6 Sep 09 Beijing

Climb the Great Wall, one of the seven wonders in the world; view the exhibits at Ming Tombs (B/L/D)

7 Sep 09 Fly Beijing – Xian

We fly to Xian, one of the most important ancient capitals; afternoon climb the ancient City Wall & Bell Tower; stay at 4 star hotel for 2 nights (B/L/-)

8 Sep 09 Xian

Explore one of the greatest archeological discovery the Terracotta Warriors, walk in the picturesque Hot Spring Park; tonight enjoy the Tang Dynasty Dinner and Show (B/L/D)

9 Sep 09 Fly Xian – Chengdu

Take a short flight to Chengdu, the capital of Sichuan Province, also named "Land of Abundance"; drive to watch the pandas at the Panda Breeding Center; stay at 4 star hotel for 1 night (B/L/D)

10 Sep 09 Chengdu – Leshan

We head to Leshan to visit the largest Buddha Statue (78 meters high) in the World; late afternoon drive to Mt Emei and stay in 4 star hotel (B/L/D)

11 Sep 09 Mt Emei

Mt Emei is regarded as Celestial Mountain and Kingdom of Buddhism, On the top you will explore the busy temples and enjoy the awe-inspiring scenery; back to Chengdu and overnight (B/L/D)

12 Sep 09 Fly Chengdu – Zhangjiajie

We fly to Zhangjiajie, known as the World Geological Park; stay at 4 star hotel for 3 nights (B/L/D)

13 Sep 09 Zhangjiajie

Full day explore the scenic areas like the Tianzi Mountain Nature Reserve and the Tianmen Mountain Natural Forest Park (B/L/D)

14 Sep Zhangjiajie

Drive to Suoxi Town to view the natural beauty of Baofeng Lake; explore the Tujia Folk Custom Park And famous Wulingyuan Scenic Areas (B/L/D)

15 Sep Fly Zhangjiajie–Shanghai

Further explore the scenery of Zhangjiajie before transfer to the airport for flight to Shanghai; arrival transfer to Bund River-view Hotel for 2 nights (B/L/D)

16 Sep 09 Shanghai

Today's highlights include walk on the Bund and Nanjing Road; visit the Yu Garden and Old China Town; cruise on the Huangpu River; bird's eye view of Shanghai on Jingmao Tower; evening enjoy the Shanghai Acrobatic Show (B/L/D)

17 Sep 09 Shanghai – Australia

Free at leisure to do more shopping before transfer to the airport for late afternoon flight home (B)

18 Sep 09 Arrive Australia
